2012 Brancott Sauvignon Blanc



We first started carrying Sauvignon Blancs from New Zealand about 20 years ago. At the time many of the wines available from the southern hemisphere seemed more a curiosity to many wine consumers while today it seems pretty routine. Sauvignon Blanc, the country's best known varietal, makes up nearly 40% of New Zealand's 40,000 acres of producing vineyards as well as 78% of its exports to the United States. Practically all of the best sauvignons come from Marlborough, a region on the Northwestern tip of the South Island. The 2012 Brancott Sauvignon Blanc, a product of the Marlborough Appellation, is a crisp, refreshing white with flavors and aromas of lime, peach and grapefruit. This would be a wonderful match with grilled oysters, barbecued prawns or salmon. This wine sees no time in oak barrels and at 13% alcohol slides down the throat with ease.
